### **ARTIST BIO**



Hiromi Tango is a Japanese Australian Artist who migrated to Australia in 1998 from Shikoku Island, Japan. She has been a resident of the Bundjalung Country, Tweed Heads, NSW since 2014.

For two decades, Hiromi Tango has focused on the intersection between art and science, with a particular focus on health and mental wellbeing. Drawing on her own experiences of neurodivergence and anxiety, her installations and performances traverse the embodied self, the emotional terrain of our relationships with others, and the healing possibilities of art. She has collaborated with numerous scientists, health professionals and research institutions, exploring how various aspects of the art- making process can contribute to positive mental wellbeing. Over the last ten years her collaboration with Dr Emma Burrows has led to major research-informed participatory art projects including Wheel – Mental Colours of Well-Being, ArtScience Museum Singapore (2022) and Rainbow Dreams, Luminato Festival Toronto (2025).

Often using textiles from her home country, Hiromi uses fabric and dress to weave complex layers of identity, emotional ties and memories. Performative works reference deep connections with Noh Theatre and cultural artforms including tea ceremony, flower arranging, calligraphy and even archery, drawing on her traditional upbringing in regional Japan.

Hiromi's work has been exhibited at major national art museums and regional galleries across Australia. Her work has also featured at international exhibitions in the United States, Belgium, Dubai and throughout Asia Pacific including Singapore, South Korea, Japan, Indonesia and New Zealand.

Recent public art projects include *Peony Dream*, Caption by Hyatt (Sydney, Australia) *GARDEN* | *Healing Together*, Tweed Valley Hospital (NSW, Australia), *MiMa - Beautiful Place*, MAP/MIMA, (Lake Macquarie City Council, NSW) and Roots, Mt Coot-tha Botanic Garden (Brisbane, Australia).

Major commissions for immersive installations specifically for children include *Kindness Garden*, National Gallery of Singapore (2025), *Red Room – Hiromi Hotel*, *Healing Garden*, The Sheikha Manal Little Artists Program, Art Dubai (2018), Sydney Contemporary: Red Room (2017), *Monster Hotel*, Out of the Box Festival, Brisbane (2014) and Dance, MCA Bella Room (2013).

Recipient of the 2017 Sidney Myer Creative Fellowship, Hiromi has been recognised through many art awards, with her work included in both the 2022 Ravenswood Women's Art Prize, and the 2022 Adelaide Perry Prize. Her work is held in major Australian public collections as well as private collections across Australia and overseas.
